Methodology:

Clarits is a vendor that provides a database that includes the demographics of a zip code based on 2010 Census estimates that were adjusted for 2017 changes. This purchased data includes CY Population counts by Households Ethnicity Language spoken at home, CY Population by Sex and Ethnicity and for the Language Spoken, and CY Population 5+ by Language spoken at home. For the Population by Language Spoken at Home and Race and Ethnicity, this database was used at a zip code level with aggregated membership for the various licensed entities and applied proportionally using the Claritas estimates to determine the number of members that speak a non-English language and their race and ethnicity.

An additional adjustment was then applied to identify the number of persons that are "Linguistically Isolated". A Linguistically Isolated household is one in which no member 14 years old and over (1) speaks only English or (2) speaks a non-English language and speaks English "very well." In other words, all members of the household who are more than 13 years old have at least some difficulty with English.

This adjustment is based on the US Census ACS Survey Table 5. Detailed Languages Spoken at Home and Ability to Speak English for the Population 5 Years and Over for California: 2009-2013

Note: Not all zip codes are included in the AMDS. Missing ZIP Codes are usually P Box, Unique (typically a single business), and APO/FPO. Other missing ZIP Codes are either obsolete ZIP Codes (no longer used by USPS) or new ZIP Codes that were created after our last update.
